ORDER

Canon 3C(1)(c) of the Code of Conduct for United States Judges and Advisory Opinion No. 57 direct federal judges to recuse themselves in those cases in which they own stock in a parent company whose subsidiary appears as a party.

Therefore, to facilitate the court's timely compliance with Canon 3C(1)(c) the United States District Court, Southern District of Mississippi adopts the following procedural directive.

Any non-governmental corporate party to an action in this court shall file a statement identifying all its parent corporations and listing any publicly held company that owns 10% or more of the party's stock. A party shall file the statement with its initial pleading filed in the court and shall supplement the statement within a reasonable time of any change in the information.

This directive shall be effective from and after the date of its adoption, November 22, 1999.
