**POSITION OVERVIEW**: The law clerk will work closely with the Judge on all aspects of the docket and will be assigned responsibility for daily monitoring of the docket, research, and writing immediately upon entering on duty. The duty station for this position is Jackson, Mississippi.

- 1. Legal research and writing; drafting orders and opinions for judicial review; providing information, guidance and advice to the Judge on legal issues relating to each case; and making recommendations to the Judge on individual cases.
- 2. Communicating with other courts, state and federal agencies, counsel, litigants, and court staff regarding court rules and procedural issues, calendaring, and other litigation matters.

**EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND EXPERIENCE**: Must be a graduate from an accredited law school. Bar membership, post-J.D. experience, and/or extensive legal research and writing experience are desired.

To qualify for JSP 11, graduation from an accredited law school is required. To qualify for JSP 12-13, legal work experience after law school and bar membership will be required. Legal work experience is progressively responsible experience in the practice of law, legal research, and legal administration, or equivalent experience, received after graduation from law school.
