- 8 "(b) The southern district comprises four divisions.

1 "(1) The Northern Division comprises the coun-2 ties of Copiah, Hinds, Holmes, Issaquena, Kemper, 3 Lauderdale, Leake, Madison, Neshoba, Newton, 4 Noxubee, Rankin, Scott, Simpson, Sharkey, Smith, 5 Warren, and Yazoo. 6 Court for the Northern Division shall be held at Jackson. 7 "(2) The Southern Division comprises the coun-8 ties of George, Greene, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, 9 Pearl River, and Stone. Court for the Southern Division shall be held at Gulfport. 11 "(3) The Eastern Division comprises the coun-12 ties of Clarke, Covington, Forrest, Jasper, Jefferson 13 Davis, Jones, Lamar, Lawrence, Marion, Perry, 14 Wayne, and Walthall.
