If you decide to submit a proposal, you will need to develop and provide both a technical proposal and a price proposal with respect to the project. Your technical proposal shall consist of any submittals required to be provided at the time proposals are due. Your price proposal shall consist of the prices you are offering for each individual item of equipment, labor, any applicable travel costs, and any other items you deem necessary to complete the project. Subject to the availability of court funds, award of this RFQ will be made to the company whose technically acceptable proposal offers the lowest and best price to the court.

The electronic submission of your offer will be acceptable, provided an original is electronically signed by an individual authorized to do so. Your proposal must be submitted no later than the close of business on April 7, 2026. Proposals received after this date and time will not be considered.
