SPECIAL ORDER # 3

In response to the Coronavirus pandemic, it is ORDERED that the in-person appearance requirement of Local Uniform Civil Rule 83.1(a)(1)(C) is temporarily suspended and attorneys seeking admission to the Southern District of Mississippi may be admitted by video- or tele-conference provided that their admission paperwork is complete and transmitted to the Clerk's Office, and provided their admission fee is paid in full. After completing and submitting the paperwork and paying the fee, counsel may contact the chambers of any District or Magistrate Judge for an admission video- or tele-conference. Attorneys planning to attend the now-cancelled spring Bar Admission ceremony will be contact by the Bar separately with further guidance.

This Order will remain in effect until the expiration or withdrawal of this Court's Special Order # 2 and any successor order or orders.
