FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF DAVID A. SANDERS AS MAGISTRATE JUDGE FOR THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT NORTHERN DISTRICT OF MISSISSIPPI

The current term of the office of United States Magistrate Judge David A. Sanders at Aberdeen, Mississippi is due to expire on June 29, 2016. The United States District Court for the Northern District of Mississippi is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight-year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge in this court include the following:

- conduct most preliminary proceedings in criminal cases;
- trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases;
- conduct various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from a district judge; and
- trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.

Comments from members of the bar and the public are invited as to whether Magistrate Judge David A. Sanders should be recommended by the panel for reappointment by the court and should be directed to:
